Mayor Skraba called the special meeting to order at 6 p.m. on May 26, 2009.

Mayor Skraba began by reading the following statement:

‘As authorized by Section 3.04 subd. 8 B of the Ely City Code and MN Statute 366.012 and MN Statute 444.075 subd. 3e, the Ely Utilities Commission is requesting the Ely City Council to certify to the County Auditor the unpaid sewer, water, electricity and other charges owing by Kori Lee Sherwood, 1545 E. Harvey St, Ely, MN; Sandra Blocker Lewis, 340 E. Conan St, Ely, MN; Laurie Spry, 1114 E Sheridan St., Ely, MN; and Davis S. Anderson, 17 E Beacon Hill Rd., Ely, MN. Notice of today’s hearing was sent on May 6, 2009 by First Class Mail to Kori Lee Sherwood, Sandra Blocker Lewis, Laurie Spry and David S. Anderson advising them of their right to appear and contest the proposed certification of these charges. Is there any representative of Kori Lee Sherwood, Sandra Blocker Lewis, Laurie Spry or David S. Anderson present who wishes to contest this proposed certification of charges?’

No representatives were present at the meeting.

Mayor Skraba then recommended approval of a Resolution certifying unpaid utility and other charges as set forth in the proposed Delinquent Utility Charges Certification to the County Auditor for collection with the property taxes of the various properties. Because time is of the essence, we would urge the Resolution to be adopted tonight and executed by the Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer for immediate filing following the statutory 15 day waiting period.
