Call to Order: Mayor Novak Called the Public Hearing to order at 5pm.

Purpose:

For public notice and comment regarding the Ely Bowling Alley's proposed three day liquor license suspension for lapsed insurance.

Attorney Klun stated that the city received notice on August 6, 2018 that the Ely Bowling Alley's insurance was canceled for non-payment on Thursday, June 28, 2018. According to Ely City Code 5.02 the council shall suspend any license for the sale of alcoholic beverages for violation of any City Code provision State or Federal Law regulating the sale of alcoholic beverages, the First violation is a license suspension for 3 days. Any suspension shall commence on the same day of the week as the violation occurred. Any Council action concerning suspension shall occur as soon as practicable.

Tim Brennen, owner of the Ely Bowling Alley, was not present at the hearing, but provided a letter to the City Council asking that the days of closure take place on Sunday, September 30th-October 3rd since they currently have children's birthday parties booked for the weekend dates prior to the requested closure dates.

Mayor Novak stated that this item is on the council agenda for tonight's meeting.
