

**WWTF Facility Plan Public Hearing Agenda
February 26, 2020 - City Hall, Council Chambers**

Pursuant to the Notice of Public Hearing regarding the Ely Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvements Facility Plan and Amendments, Mayor Chuck Novak opened the public hearing at 5:31 PM.
